Opening Ceremony of Professionals' Programme - 2014

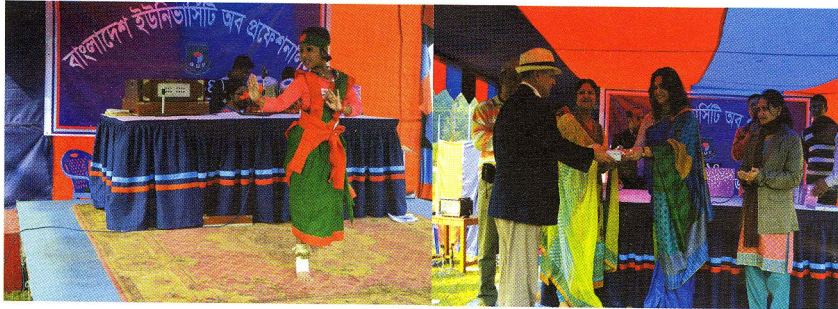

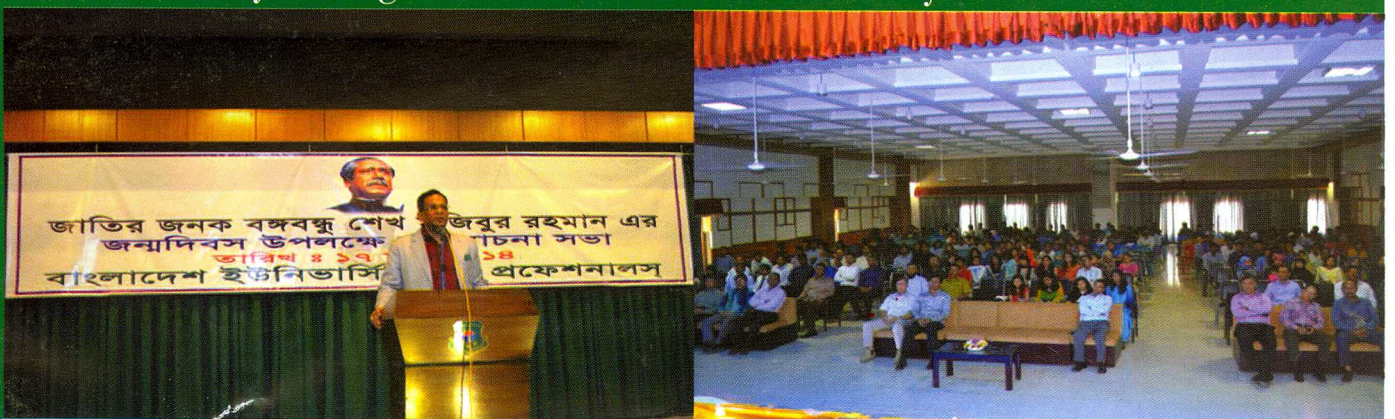


Seminar on Non Market Strategy & Business Environment Management
